
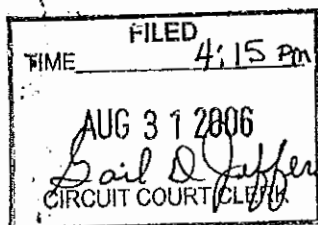


# Oath of Office




